Coaches, Managers and Report writers can you start to write your reports for the end of year book which will be required the week after Grand Final. Coaches you will also need to nominate your 3 awards for the year. These awards can be called whatever you like. i.e. Best and Fairest, Best Back etc



This event will book out very quickly, if you would like to attend please book early.

Following is important information that all coaches, parents and officials should be aware of for the Finals Series.

MOD Games (U9 - U12)

- * No time off in first half
- * A maximum of five (5) minutes time off in the second half, as signalled by the Referee
- * Each registered player must complete one full half of the match
- * If a registered player is not available for their scheduled match, information must be provided to the satisfaction of the Ground Manager and BDJRL of the player's absence. If necessary, the player's parent will be contacted.
- * A player taken from the field through injury must retake the field within three minutes or may take no further part in the match -

The First Aid Officer will be the final judge whether or player may continue or not.

- * Managers must sit at either end of the Official Table and not participate in the game.
- * Trainers must remain in their areas and not walk up and down and except recognised breaks in play, Trainers are not to enter field of play unless attending an injured player.
- * Coaches must adhere to the rules and spirit of the game
- * Clubs must be aware that they are responsible for the conduct of their players, spectators, coaches and parents and be reminded that Balmain has a zero tolerance policy to bad behaviour.

Procedure for Drawn Games in Semi Final and Final

If game is drawn at the conclusion of the second half

- * There will be a coin toss to determine who kicks and receives
- * Five (5) minutes will be played each way changeover immediately.
- * If the game is still a draw at the conclusion of extra time a further five (5) minutes gold point period is played
- * If the game is still a draw, then the match will be replayed
